### **Saturday November 6<sup>th</sup> 2010 – Chislehurst Rotary Fireworks Event**

**Place:** Chislehurst Recreation Ground (via Walden Road or Empress Drive) BR7 5BG

**Time:** Gates open 6pm. Bonfire lit at 7pm followed by fireworks at 7.30pm

**Cost:** On the gate: £3.00 (children) £6.00 adults. ADVANCE from local shops: £2.50 (children) and £5.00 (adults). Where to buy advance tickets: see below

Visitors to Chislehurst recreation ground can expect another spectacular Rotary firework display this year and all the usual excitement of the funfair on Saturday November 6<sup>th</sup>. The recreation ground will be open from 6pm using the Walden Road and Empress Drive entrances. Look out for your friendly local Rotarians at the gates!

Tony Wells of Chislehurst Rotary Club said: "This is the best firework show in the area and has a well-deserved local reputation for being a fun event. We have been lucky with the weather in previous years and hope to be so again. We look forward to welcoming everyone along on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> and because local Rotarians do all the organisation as volunteers, every penny of profit goes to a range of deserving charities here and abroad. In a good year that means around £10,000 or more is distributed to charities."

Tickets cost £3 for children (£6 adults) on the gate, or are cheaper if you get them in advance from a range of shops in Chislehurst and the surrounding area (see below). Entrances to the recreation ground are in Empress Drive (behind Sainsburys), and Walden Road.

Local charities which have benefited from funds from Chislehurst Rotary Club include: Mottingham Children's Project, Marjorie McClure School, local hospices, Bromley Alzheimers Society and many more.
