Chislehurst Rotary Club has raised funds to donate a Flowtron Hydroven system to help some of the residents who live at St Cecilians (Leonard Cheshire Disability) in Sundridge Avenue, *Bickley*. The equipment, which costs more than £1,000, helps ease swelling and discomfort as well as improving circulation for those with limited mobility.

Representatives of Chislehurst Rotary Club went to see this latest piece of equipment demonstrated by Mrs Ranjana Chauhan, who lives at St Cecilians. Ranjana says: *"The equipment is simple to use and makes a big difference to my life and that of others with similar conditions. Anything that helps reduce the swelling and discomfort in my limbs is most welcome."*

Jackie Overton, the Physiotherapist at St Cecilia's, added: *"This equipment, donated by Chislehurst Rotary Club, is very welcome. We have several people here who will be able to benefit from using it. We are very grateful to the Rotary Club for their help."*

Harold South, past President of Chislehurst Rotary Club said: *"We are delighted to help with work like this that goes on in our local area. All those who come to our firework display and contribute to our Christmas collections can be reassured that we use every penny they donate wisely. The majority of our donations go to local projects and we are glad to be able to help some of the residents of St Cecilians this year."*

St Cecilia's has 30 residents, some of whom live there for many years with the support of the dedicated team of employees and volunteers who work there.
